### Teaching & Learning Activities

In this section there are separate biographies of 15 famous individuals describing the significant and active roles that they played in the Peace Movement.

#### Task/Exercise

Working in pairs or small groups pupils could be allocated an individual; using the following template each group could summarise the major influences that impacted on their person becoming a committed individual working for peace. It may be appropriate for pupils to only use key words to complete the table.

Following completion each group could then feed into plenary discussion to see whether there are any common features. Teachers may wish to complete a table as the discussion progresses whilst pointing out the significance of any common features.
